In this presentation, viewers will discover a range of techniques for capturing architecture in a truly impactful manner. Wayne will discuss the importance of perspective, explore the zone system for black and white work, review the optimal equipment for architectural photography and delve into the realm of post-processing techniques.

Wayne Fisher is a professional photographer and educator based in Thornhill, Ontario. He hails from South Africa and says that this background, growing up with a strict adherence to rules, has had a profound influence on his photography and has influenced how his personal style has diverged away from the conventional approach to architectural photography. He possesses a unique and innovative approach to Architectural Photography. With a discerning eye, he dissects his subjects, highlighting the most significant elements and bringing them to the forefront.

His work has garnered international recognition, being featured in prestigious publications such as Chizz Magazine, Collector Book/New perspectives by Contemporary Art Curator Magazine, and Flowers of Monet: 180th Anniversary of Claude Monet in 2021. A significant milestone in Wayne's career was representing Canada at the World Photographic Cup 2020 in the commercial category.
