Magic of Autumn by Kasandra Sproson

In this talk, Kasandra Sproson shows images that were crafted with emotional intent, giving a description of the techniques she used to create artistic imagery rather than simply making record shots.

Kasandra Sproson has been a passionate photographer in the Lower Mainland for the last 15 years. Initially her images were reflective of detailed depth and she taught in person macro classes to share her knowledge. Expanding into a more creative genre her images received numerous awards and were featured in magazines and used commercially for promotional purposes. She has shifted her focus over the last few years to creative flower photography, often incorporating traditional art styles into her photography.

Kasandra teaches regularly in small intimate groups locally, zoom presentations, etc. She has been one of a group of internationally renowned photographers, teaching unique processes and is part of an extensive workshop, Phlorography Online with Jackie Kramer.

Always wanting to remove perceived boundaries and work toward self expression, she is known for her utilization of Japanese textured papers and her own alcohol ink creations incorporated into her photography. Currently she is exploring methods to create beautiful water colour style images and is presenting this technique of hers in the current year's Phlorography Online 2025. Kasandra has moved beyond struggling to achieve what is the “norm” and works toward expressing her artistic vision through non traditional means.
